

THE NHSCPA YP COMMITTEE PRESENTS THE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

ABOUT THE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

The program will begin in late August with a two night stay at a remote hotel, with two additional days of meetings, one in December and one in May, to cover all pertinent material.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAM

The objective of the Leadership Program is to provide an opportunity for young people in the accounting profession, who have stood out as potential future leaders, to develop and foster the skills that they will need to be strong leaders in the future. The program is focused on training in the areas of leadership, communication, and management skills. Each day would be a full 8 hours and each participant would receive 16 CPE credits for participating in the program. The project is dependent upon a small group of participants who are willing to cultivate their leadership skills and work as a team. Participants will be chosen by nomination only and each New Hampshire public accounting firm will be asked to nominate one young leader to participate.

LODGING INFORMATION

Hotel stay would be required in order to help foster a bond between the participants so that they are better able to work as a team and interact with each other over the course of the program. For this, we are working with the White Mountain Hotel and Resort in North Conway, NH

POLITICAL AND COMMUNITY UPDATE DAY

In approximately early December the group would reunite and spend the day in Concord, NH at the State House speaking with different political leaders.

The group would use this day to make connections with different political leaders and gain a greater understanding of how they can impact the community in which they live and work.

NEW HAMPSHIRE BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS DAY

In early May the group would again reunite in Manchester to travel the city for the day meeting with different business leaders. The group would travel Manchester to the offices of companies in a variety of industries. At each stop the group would meet with the owner or an executive that would speak about the leadership within the organization as well as the company's community involvement.

- Business Writing (4 Cr)
- Lunch and discussion
- Management Skills (4 Cr)

Day Two:

- Networking/Public Speaking (4 Cr)
- Lunch and discussion
- Leadership Training (4 Cr)
